## **Conference Report**

Educational Development Council (EDC) organised two days International Conference on Education and Global Peace on 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> March 2018 at Teachers Training College, Buddha Institute of Technology Campus, BodhGaya in collaboration with Department of Education, Magadh University, BodhGaya. The chairman (EDC) Dr. Kamal Prasad Bauddha and General Secretary (EDC) Dr Shailaj Kumar Shrivastava planned to organise an International Conference to be organised at BodhGaya to bring together academician and scholar from all over India and abroad to deliberate on theme Education and Global Peace which could help in bringing peace in present chaotic world. EDC management committee finalised the venue and theme of the conference. After several meeting with respected members of EDC several committee and subcommittee were formed for the conference. The conference Brochure was widely circulated on our website and with our members. EDC received unbelievable response from different states of India and abroad in short time. The delegate from countries like Ceylon, Vietnam, Cambodia, Tibet, Nepal, Russia, and India were participated in the conference. Nearly 300 papers along with abstract were received. Among those 153 papers were in English and 139 papers were in Hindi language on various subthemes viz, Human Right Education and Global Peace, Global Peace through I.C.T., Teaching & Learning: A Tool of Global Peace, Role of Social and cultural Milieu in Global Peace, Education and Global Peace in International Perspective, Science Education and Global Peace, Environmental Education & Global Peace, Role of Religious Education & Global Peace, Road Map of Future Development of Education, Global Peace as Depicted in

Religious/ Secular Literature, Policies of Education Peace, Women Education and Global Peace, Education, Peace and Integral Harmony, Child Right Education and Peace, Pedagogy of Education and Peace etc. The Editorial Board members spent their valuable time to bring out the souvenir.

The programme was started at scheduled time with lightening the candle by chief guest and distinguished guest of honour followed by welcome song by students. The Chairman Dr. Kamal Prasad Bauddha gives welcome address to all guests and delegates. The Chief Guest and guest of honours sitting on the dais were felicitated by flower bouquet and shawl by Chairman and General Secretary (EDC). Ven. Bhantey P. Sewalee Thero, General Secretary, Mahabodhi Society, Dr. Lam, President, International Buddhist Federation, Vietnam, Ven. Pragyadeep, President, all India Bikshu Sangh, delivered very impressive inaugural lecture. At least 17(seventeen) great personalities were given excellence award with shawl and mementos for their outstanding contribution in the field of education, research and services by our chief guest. Agarwal, and Dr. Shailaj Kumar Shrivastava. Academic session was coordinated by Dr. Gulam Mohmad Ansari. In first day after inaugural session, all together 88 papers were presented by the delegates in four academic sessions. Academic session followed by high tea and all delegates meet together and get introduced. In the evening, all delegates enjoyed and appreciated cultural programme by students and teachers.

Next day, all delegates presented their papers in two parallel academic sessions till lunch. The total papers were presented in four technical sessions into two parallel sessions. Due to paucity of time the total 102 papers presented followed by questions-answers and

discussion among the scholars. After lunch, valedictory session started. Dr. Sita Ram Singh, former Registrar and DSW, Magadh University was the chief guest and he delivered his presidential speech. He suggested that first peace should be established within individual, then in society and then in globe. Dr. Kaushal Kumar, Dept. Global Peace and social goals is the subject matter of discussion in the International conference. The ideal educational reform is required to create structures, programs and curricula that are technically advanced, practically employable, rationally encouraging and developing human resources for social unity, peace, scientific spirit, industrial progress and moral values.
